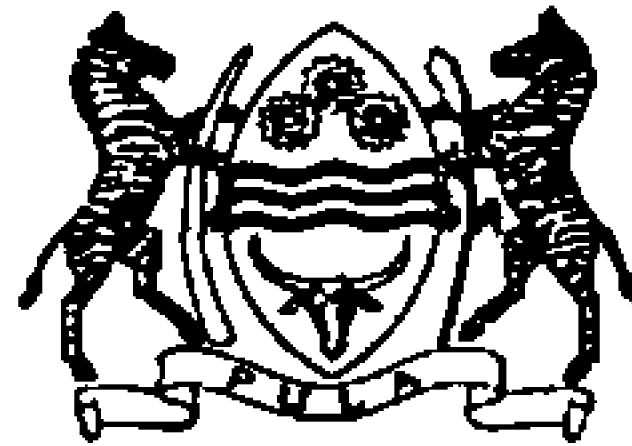

SECTION

1. Short title
2. Consolidated Fund charged with further sum
3. Development Fund charged with further sum

SCHEDULE

An Act to make further payment out of the Consolidated Fund and the Development Fund to meet expenditure incurred during the year ending 31st March, 1994.

Date of Assent: 5th April, 1995.

Date of Commencement: 10th April, 1995.

ENACTED by the Parliament of Botswana.

1. This Act may be cited as the Supplementary Appropriation (1993/1994) Act, 1995.

Short title

2. The Consolidated Fund is hereby charged with a further sum of P85 460 258 (eighty five million four hundred and sixty thousand two hundred and fifty eight Pula) to meet expenditure incurred during the financial year ending on 31st March, 1994, in excess of the amount already appropriated for the services for that year, according to the particulars set forth in the Schedule.

The Development Fund is hereby charged with a further sum of P58 016 532 (fifty eight million, sixteen thousand, five hundred and thirty two Pula) to meet expenditure incurred during the financial year ending 31st March, 1994, in excess of the amount already appropriated for development projects for that year.
