An Act to amend the University of Botswana Act

Date of Assent: 8th February, 1995.

Date of Commencement: 17th February, 1995.

ENACTED by the Parliament of Botswana

1. This Act may be cited as the University of Botswana (Amendment) Act, 1995.

Short title

2. The University of Botswana Act, hereinafter referred to as "the Act", is amended by replacing section 3 thereof by the following section —

"Aims "3. (1) The aims of the University shall be to provide higher education, to undertake research and to disseminate knowledge.

(2) Without prejudice to the generality of subsection (1), the University Council may, on the advice of the Senate, approve the establishment of relationships with other persons or bodies, or other institutions of learning, higher education, training or research, within or outside Botswana, upon such terms as may be provided in statutes enacted by the University Council in accordance with the provisions of section 15."

3. Section 4 of the Act is amended by substituting for the words "and the Vice-Chancellor" the words ", the Vice-Chancellor and such Deputy Vice-Chancellors as may be appointed in accordance with the provisions of section 7(3)".

4. Section 7 of the Act is amended by substituting for subsection (3) thereof the following subsections —

“(3) There shall be appointed by the University Council such number of Deputy Vice-Chancellors as the Council, may, after consultation with the Senate, and in accordance with statutes enacted by the Council in that behalf, from time to time determine.

(4) When the post of Vice-Chancellor is vacant, or when the Vice-Chancellor is absent, or for any reason unable to perform the functions of Vice-Chancellor, there shall be appointed, in accordance with statutes enacted by the University Council in that behalf, one of the Deputy Vice-Chancellors to act as Vice-Chancellor, or if no Deputy Vice-Chancellor is available, any other suitable member of the University staff may be appointed to so act.”.

of section 8

5. Section 8(1) of the Act is amended —

(a) by deleting paragraph (b) therefrom;

(b) by adding immediately after the word “Minister” the words “, two of whom shall be public officers appointed by office, or their alternates”;

(c) by adding after paragraph (i) thereof the following new paragraphs —

“(j) one person, being a member of, and selected by, the Governing Council of the Botswana College of Agriculture;

(k) one person being the representative of the non-academic staff of the University.”.

Deletion
of section 10

6. The Act is amended by the deletion therefrom of section 10:

Provided that the present incumbents of the posts of Registrar, Bursar and Librarian shall continue in office until the University Council makes suitable arrangements to abolish or replace such posts, or for their continuation.
