AMENDMENT OF SCHEDULES (NO. 23) NOTICE, 1995
(Published on 10th November, 1995)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the Minister of Finance and Development Planning by sections 52 and 53 of the Customs and Excise Duty Act, the Schedules to the Act are proposed to be amended to the extent set out in the Schedule below.

Part 4 of Schedule No. 1

NOTES: By the substitution for Notes 7(p) and (q) of the following:

- “(p) bulls, being pure-bred animals of subheading No. 0102.10, in such quantities as the Permanent Secretary, Ministry of Agriculture may allow by specific permit;
- (q) recorded magnetic tapes, of a width not exceeding 4 mm, commonly known as books-on-tape; or
- (r) video tape duplicators, cassette type, not incorporating a video reproducing device, of subheading No. 8521.10.”
