IMMIGRATION (EXEMPTION) ORDER, 1995
(Published on 26th May, 1995)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 23(1) of the Immigration Act, the Minister of Labour and Home Affairs has made the following Order —

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| 1. This Order may be cited as the Immigration (Exemption) Order, 1995. | Citation |
| 2. The expatriate employees and long term consultants of the Botswana Institute for Development Policy and Analysis, their spouses and any dependants under the age of 18, are hereby exempted from obtaining residence permits in order to reside in Botswana, for so long as they remain so employed, and provided that they are in possession of valid passports or other certificates of identity. | Exemptions |
