ARRANGEMENT OF BYE-LAWS

BYE-LAW

1. Citation
2. Levy of rates
3. When rates due and payable

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on it by regulation 30 as read with regulation 31 of the Town Council Regulations, and with the approval of the Minister of Local Government, Lands and Housing, the Francistown Town Council hereby makes the following Bye-Laws —

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| Citation | 1. These Bye-Laws may be cited as the Francistown Town Council 1996/97 Rating Bye-Laws, 1996. |
| Levy of rates | 2. The property rates payable in Francistown Township for the period 1996/97 shall be at the rate of —
(a) 0,80 thebe in the Pula in respect of all improved rateable land used for residential purposes, and 1,00 thebe in the Pula in respect of all improved rateable land used for industrial or commercial purposes;
and
(b) 3,20 thebe in the Pula in respect of all unimproved rateable land used for residential purposes, and 4,00 thebe in the Pula in respect of all unimproved rateable land used for commercial or industrial purposes. |
| When rates due and payable | 3. The rates fixed in bye-law 2 shall become due and payable, by the person liable to pay such rates, at the commencement of these Bye-Laws. |
