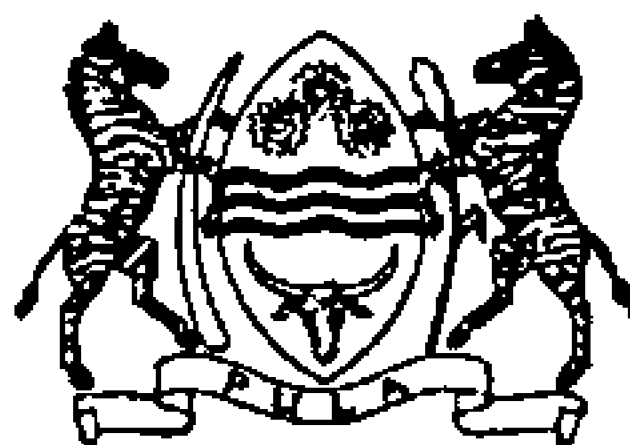
IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 34 of the Immigration Act, the Minister of Labour and Home Affairs hereby makes the following Regulations —

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Immigration (Amendment) Regulations, 1996. Citation

2. The Immigration Regulations (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Regulations”) are amended by inserting therein immediately after regulation 18 thereof, the following new regulation 18A — Insertion of  
new regulation  
18A in Cap.  
25:02  
(sub.leg)

“Application for a certificate of permanent residence 18A (1) An application for a certificate of permanent residence in terms of section 23 (3) of the Act shall be in Form 22 set out in the Schedule and shall be accompanied by a fee of P100.00.  
(2) The certificate of permanent residence shall be in Form 23 set out in the Schedule and shall be valid for such period and on such terms and conditions therein specified.”

4. The Schedule to the Immigration Regulations is amended by inserting therein the following new Form 22 and Form 23 — Amendment

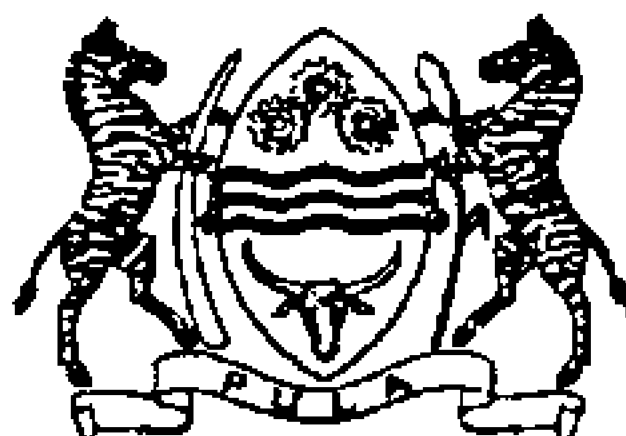
