ARRANGEMENT OF PARAGRAPHS

PARAGRAPHS

1. Citation and commencement
2. New minimum wages

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on him by section 142 of the Employment Act, the Minister of Labour and Home Affairs, having duly considered the recommendations of the Minimum Wages Advisory Board, hereby makes the following Order—

1. This Order may be cited as the Regulation of Minimum Wages Order, 1996 and shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st of April, 1996.

2. Notwithstanding the provisions of the Regulation of Wages (Building, Construction, Exploration and Quarrying Industries) Order, the Regulation of Wages (Wholesale and Retail Distributive Trades) Order, the Regulation of Wages (Manufacturing Service and Repair Trades) Order, the Regulation of Wages (Hotel, Catering and Entertainment Trades) Order and the Regulation of Wages (Garage, Motor Trade and Road Transport) Order, the basic minimum wages to be paid to employees in the undermentioned trades or industries shall be as indicated in relation thereto, and the Orders mentioned herein shall be deemed to be amended accordingly —
