ARRANGEMENT OF BYE-LAWS

BYE-LAW

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 29 of the Local Government (District Councils) Act, the Kgatleng District Council has, with the approval of the Minister of Local Government, Lands and Housing, made the following Bye-Laws —

Citation

1. These Bye-Laws may be cited as the Kgatleng District Council (Noise and Nuisance) (Amendment) Bye-Laws, 1998.

2. Bye-Law 5 of the Kgatleng District Council (Noise and Nuisance) (Amendment) Bye-Laws (herein after referred to as the Bye-Laws) is amended in sub-bye-law (1) thereof, by substituting for the time “4 p.m” which appears therein, the time “10 p. m”.

of bye-law 6
of the
Bye-laws

3. The Bye-Laws are amended by substituting for bye-law 6 thereof, the following new bye-law—

“6. (1) Any person who contravenes the provision of these Bye—
Laws shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding P100, and in default of payment thereof to imprisonment for a term not exceeding 21 days, or for a second or subsequent offence to a fine not exceeding P200 and in default of payment thereof to imprisonment for a term not exceeding two months.

(2) A person found to have contravened the provisions of the Bye-Laws, may be, and shall be for a second or subsequent transgression, prosecuted and upon conviction shall be liable to have the instrument, bell, horn, wireless, record player, amplifier or similar device by means of which the offence was committed, confiscated, and to a fine not exceeding P200 and in default of payment thereof to imprisonment for a term not exceeding two months.
