LEGAL PRACTITIONERS (EXEMPTION FROM PUPILLAGE)
REGULATIONS, 1998
(Published on 17th April, 1998)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the Chief Justice by section 54(a) of the Legal Practitioners Act, 1996, and in consultation with the Minister of Presidential Affairs and Public Administration and the Council, the following Regulations are hereby made —

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Legal Practitioners (Exemption from Pupillage) Regulations, 1998. Citation

2. Any person who holds the degree of LL.B. conferred on him by the University of Botswana immediately before 31st December, 1997, and has been admitted and enrolled as a legal practitioner shall be exempted from entering into a contract of pupillage in terms of section 18 of the Act. Exemption from pupillage
