ARRANGEMENT OF REGULATIONS

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the President by section 4 of the Pensions Act, the following Regulations are hereby made —

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Pensions (Amendment) Regulations, 1998, and shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1st January, 1998.

2. Regulation 4 of the Regulations in the Schedule to the Pensions Act (in these Regulations referred to as “the Regulations”) is hereby amended by substituting for subregulation (3) thereof, the following new subregulation —

“(3) A pension payable to a public officer under this regulation shall be at the rate of one four-hundred and fiftieth of his pensionable emoluments in respect of each completed month of pensionable service.”.

3. Regulation 9 of the Regulations is hereby amended by deleting paragraph (c) of subregulation (2) thereof.

4. Regulation 26 of the Regulations is amended by adding at the end of subregulation (3) thereof, the following new subregulation —

“(4) An industrial class worker may, after every five years' continuous service and on application to the Minister, be granted a gratuity at the rate of five weeks' pay for each completed year of service.”.
