**PROHIBITION OF SALE OF IMPORTED CATTLE TO
BOTSWANA MEAT COMMISSION (FOR EXPORT TO THE
EUROPEAN UNION) REGULATIONS, 1998**
(Published on 18th December, 1998)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the Minister of Agriculture by section 19 of the Diseases of Animals Act, the following Regulations are hereby made —

Citation **1.** These Regulations may be cited as the Prohibition of Sale of Imported Cattle to the Botswana Meat Commission for Export to the European Union Regulations, 1998.

Interpretation **2.** In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires,
“imported cattle” means cattle not born and bred in Botswana.

Importing cattle **3.** A person importing cattle into Botswana shall within seven days of the importation, place on the right shoulder of the imported cattle the following brand —

“N O
E U”.

Prohibition of buying of imported cattle by the meat commission **4.** The Botswana Meat Commission shall not buy or slaughter for export to the European Union, cattle branded in accordance with regulation 3.

Offence and penalty **5.** A person who contravenes regulation 3, commits an offence and is liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding P500 or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding six months or to both.
