ARRANGMENT OF BYE-LAWS

BYE-LAW

2. Amendment of Bye-laws 3, 8, 10, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 19, 32 and 34 of Cap. 40:02 (Sub. Leg.)
3. Amendment of Bye-laws 4, 5, 6, 9, 18, 20, 25, 26, 27, 28, 29, 30, 31 and 33 of the Bye-laws

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by regulation 30 as read with regulation 31 of the Town Council Regulations, and with the approval of the Minister of Local Government, Lands and Housing, the Jwaneng Town Council hereby makes the following Bye-laws —

Citation 1. These Bye-laws may be cited as the Jwaneng Town Council (General) (Amendment) Bye-laws, 1999.

Amendment of Bye-laws 3, 8, 10, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 19, 32 and 34 of Cap. 40:02 (Sub. Leg.) 2. Bye-laws 3, 8, 10, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 19, 32, and 34 of the Jwaneng Town Council (General) Bye-laws (hereinafter referred to as the "Bye-laws"), are amended —

- (a) by substituting in each bye-law for the amount "P10" wherever it appears therein, the amount "P50";
- (b) by substituting in each bye-law for the word "fourteen" wherever it appears therein, the words "twenty-one";
- (c) by substituting in each bye-law for the amount "P50" where it appears therein, the amount "P100";
- (d) by substituting in each bye-law for the word "two" which appears immediately before the word "months" wherever it appears therein, the word "three".

Amendment of Bye-laws 4, 5, 6, 9, 18, 20, 25, 26, 27, 28, 29, 30, 31 and 33 of the Bye-laws 3. Bye-laws 4, 5, 6, 9, 18, 20, 25, 26, 27, 28, 29, 30, 31 and 33 of the "Bye-laws" are amended —

- (a) by substituting in each bye-law for the amount "P100" wherever it appears therein, the amount "P200";
- (d) by substituting in each bye-law for the word "three" which appears immediately before the word "months" wherever it appears therein, the word "six".
