IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the Minister for Presidential Affairs and Public Administration by section 209(3) of the Criminal Procedure and Evidence Act, the following Regulations are hereby made —

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Tariff of Allowances (Witnesses in Criminal Cases) (Amendment) Regulations, 1999, and shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1st April, 1999.

2. Regulation 3 of the Tariff of Allowances (Witnesses in Criminal Cases) Regulations, 1994 (hereinafter referred to as the “Regulations”) is hereby amended —

- (a) in sub-regulation (1) (a) thereof, by substituting for the amount “P50” there in the amount “P250”;
- (b) in sub-regulation (1) (b) thereof, by substituting for the amount “P45” there in the amount “P200”;
- (c) in sub-regulation (1) (c) thereof, by substituting for the amount “P35” there in the amount “P100”;
- (d) in sub-regulation (1) (d) thereof, by substituting for the amount “P30” there in the amount “P75”;
- (e) in sub-regulation (1) (e) thereof, by substituting for the amount “P25” there in the amount “P60”;

3. Regulation 4 of the Regulations is hereby amended by substituting for sub-regulation (2) thereof, the following new sub-regulation —

“(2) Where a witness comes in a motor car or lorry from a distance of over 8 kilometres from the seat of the Court, and rail travel is not reasonably available the amount payable shall be such amount as prescribed for public servants under the Public Service Act”.
