ARRANGEMENT OF REGULATIONS

REGULATIONS

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the Minister of Local Government, Lands and Housing by section 37 of the Tribal Land Act, the following Regulations are hereby made —

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Tribal Land (Amendment) Regulations, 1999. Citation

2. The Tribal Land Regulations (hereinafter referred to as “the Regulations”) are amended — Amendment

(a) by substituting for sub-regulations (2) thereof, the following new sub-regulation —

“(2) Within three months from the end of each financial year, every Land Board shall cause its accounts for the preceding financial year to be balanced and an annual statement or abstract of such accounts to be prepared and presented to the Auditor-General.”;

(b) by substituting for sub-regulation (3) thereof, the following new sub-regulation —

“(3) Such accounts with all books, vouchers and papers relating thereto, with a copy of such annual statement or abstract shall be audited by the Auditor-General, who shall carry out his duties in accordance with the provisions of section 124 (2) of the Constitution of Botswana and section 38 of the Finance and Audit Act.”;

(c) by inserting immediately after sub-regulation (3) thereof, the following sub-regulation —

“(3A) The Auditor-General shall complete the audit of accounts within twelve months of their submission to him.”;

(d) by substituting for sub-regulation (4) thereof, the following new sub-regulation —

“(4) The Auditor-General’s report and the audited statement shall be submitted to the —

- (i) Minister;
- (ii) Minister responsible for finance and development planning: and
- (iii) Chief Executive Officer, who shall cause the report and the audited statement to be tabled before the Land Board.”

(e) in sub-regulation (5) by substituting for the word “auditor” contained therein the words “Board Secretary”.

3. Regulation 33 of the Regulations is amended —

(a) by substituting for the word “auditor” wherever it appears therein the words “Board Secretary”;

(b) by substituting for the word “Minister” wherever it appears therein the words “Permanent Secretary.”
