ARRANGEMENT OF REGULATIONS

REGULATION

3. Amendment of First Schedule to principal Regulations

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the Minister of Commerce and Industry by section 3 of the Control of Goods, Prices and Other Charges Act, the following Regulations are hereby made —

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Control of Goods (Import and Export of Agricultural Products) (Amendment) Regulations, 2000.

Citation

2. The Control of Goods (Import and Export of Agricultural Products) Regulations (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Regulations”) are hereby amended by substituting, for regulation 5 thereof, the following new regulation —

“Application
for permit

(1) An application for an import or export permit, as the case may be under these Regulations, shall be made to the authorized officer, and such application shall contain such information and shall be accompanied by such documents as may be specified by the authorized officer.

(2) Any person applying for an import permit under these Regulations shall produce, to the authorized officer, such information or documents as the officer may require, proving that at least 50% of the maize meal, samp or animal feed for poultry and livestock, as the case may be, and which is the subject of his application, was obtained in Botswana.”

3. The principal Regulations are hereby amended by inserting, in their proper alphabetical order in the First Schedule, the following words —

“animal feed for poultry and livestock.”
