IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the Minister of Commerce and Industry by section 3 of the Control of Goods, Prices and Other Charges Act, the following Regulations are hereby made —

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| 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Control of Goods (Liquified Petroleum Gas Cylinders) Regulations, 2000. | Citation |
| 2. In these Regulations, unless the context otherwise requires, “liquified petroleum gas cylinder” means a vessel approved for storage and carriage of liquified petroleum gas and is of any of the following capacities;
9; 14; 19 and 48 kilograms. | Interpretation |
| 3. No person shall import or export liquified petroleum gas cylinders bearing the brand or trade name of a company without the written permission of the company. | Restriction on

| 4. A person who contravenes regulation 3 commits an offence and is liable to conviction to a fine not exceeding P500 or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding six months, or to both such fine and imprisonment. | Offence and
penalty |
