ARRANGEMENT OF REGULATIONS

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the President by section 177 of the Botswana Defence Force Act, the following Regulations are hereby made—

Short title

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Defence Force (Regular Force) (Officers) (Amendment) Regulations, 2000.

2. The Defence Force (Regular Force) (Officers) Regulations (in these Regulations referred to as “the Regulations”) are amended by substituting for regulation 33 (2) thereof the following new regulation —

“(2) Subject to this regulation, annual leave shall accrue to any officer at the following rates —

- (a) for every period of qualifying service amounting to 365 days, 30 working days;
- (b) for every period of qualifying service amounting to less than 365 working days, two and half working days per month.

Insertion of
Regulation
39 (8)

3. The Regulations are amended by inserting immediately after regulation 39 (7) thereof the following —

“(8) An officer who is discharged from the Force due to ill-health, arising from his physical or mental condition, shall be granted free travelling facilities to his place of residence in Botswana, or if he resides outside Botswana, to the place on the borders of Botswana nearest to his place of residence.”
