ARRANGEMENT OF REGULATIONS

REGULATION

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the President by section 177 of the Botswana Defence Force Act, the following Regulations are hereby made—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Defence Force (Regular Force) (Other Ranks) (Amendment) Regulations, 2000. Citation

2. The Defence Force (Regular Force) (Other Ranks) Regulations (referred to in these Regulations as “the Regulations”) are amended by substituting for regulation 21 (2) thereof the following new regulation — Replacement
of Regulation
21 (2) of
Cap. 21:05
Sub. Leg.

“(2) subject to this regulation leave shall accrue to a member at the following rates —

(a) for every period of qualifying service amounting to 365 days,
25 working days;

(b) for every period of qualifying service amounting to less than
365 working days, two working days per month.

3. Regulation 27 (2) of the Regulations is amended by substituting thereof the following — Replacement
of Regulation
27 (2)

“(2) A member who retires during the period of his engagement or who is discharged from the force due to ill-health, arising from his physical or mental condition, shall be granted free travelling facilities to his place of residence in Botswana, or if he resides outside Botswana, to the place on the borders of Botswana nearest to his place of residence.”
