IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the Minister of Labour and Home Affairs by section 22 of the Employment of Non-Citizens Act, the following Regulations are hereby made —

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| 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Employment of Non-Citizens (Amendment) Regulations, 2000. | Citation |
| 2. Regulation 2 of the Employment of Non-Citizens Regulations, hereinafter referred to as “the Regulations”, is amended by substituting for subregulation (3) thereof, the following new subregulation —
“(3) An application for the issue or renewal of a work permit shall be accompanied by a fee of —
(a) P200 for each year of stay, in the case of an application for a work permit; and
(b) P200, in the case of an application for renewal of a work permit.”. | Amendment of regulation 2, of Cap. 47:02 Sub.Leg. |
| 3. Regulation 5 of the Regulations is amended by substituting for the amount “P15” contained therein, the amount “P100”. | Amendment of regulation 5 of the Regulations |
| 4. Regulation 9 of the Regulations is amended by substituting for the amount “P5.00” contained therein, the amount “P100”. | Amendment of regulation 9 of the Regulations |
| 5. The First Schedule to the Regulations is amended —
(a) by substituting for the first paragraph appearing in Form No. 1 (a) the following new paragraph—
“ Four copies to be submitted to the Commissioner of Labour, Private Bag 0072, Gaborone, with three passport size photographs and a fee of P200 for each year of stay in respect of a work permit, and P200 in respect of each renewal of a work permit. Self-employed persons shall use Form 1 (b). Applications for renewal should be made three months before expiry date.”; and | Amendment of First Schedule |

(b) by substituting the first paragraph appearing in Form No.1 (b) the following new paragraph —

“ Four copies to be submitted to the Commissioner of Labour, Private Bag 0072, Gaborone, with three passport size photographs and a fee of P200 for each year of stay in respect of a work permit, and P200 in respect of each renewal of a work permit. Employees shall use Form 1 (a). Applications for renewal should be made three months before expiry date.”.
