ARRANGEMENT OF BYE-LAWS

BYE-LAW

1. Citation
2. Levy of rates
3. When rates due and payable

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by regulation 30 as read with regulation 31 of the Town Council Regulations, and with the approval of the Minister of Local Government, the Gaborone City Council hereby makes the following Bye-Laws —

1. These Bye-Laws may be cited as the Gaborone City Council (1999/2000) Rating Bye-laws, 2000. Citation
2. The property rates payable in Gaborone City for the period 1999/2000 shall be at the rate of — Levy of rates
 - (a) 0,43 thebe in the Pula in respect of all improved rateable land used for residential purposes and 0,52 thebe in the Pula in respect of all improved rateable land used for commercial or industrial purposes;
 - (b) 1,71 thebe in the Pula in respect of all unimproved rateable land used for residential purposes, and 2,08 thebe in the Pula in respect of all unimproved rateable land used for commercial or industrial purposes, and
 - (c) 0,20 thebe in the Pula in respect of all improved rateable land used for agricultural purposes, and 0,08 thebe in the Pula in respect of all unimproved rateable land used for agricultural purposes.
3. The rates fixed in bye-law 2 shall become due and payable, by the person liable to pay such rates, at the commencement of these Bye-Laws. When rates due and payable
