| 2. The Control of Goods (Restriction on Importation of Wheat Flour) Regulations are hereby amended by substituting, for regulation 4 thereof, the following new regulation — | Amendment

| “Application
for import
permit | 4. (1) An application for a permit to import wheat flour shall be made to the authorised officer, and such application shall contain such information, and shall be accompanied by such documents, as may be specified by the authorised officer.
(2) A person who is granted an import permit under these Regulations shall pay a 15% levy on all types of wheat flour that he imports.
(3) Subregulation (2) shall not apply to a consignment of wheat flour donated to the Botswana Government or any organization or person for purposes of drought relief, or to the importation, by any person, of an amount not exceeding 12.5 kg of wheat flour for his personal consumption.” |
