1. Citation
2. Declaration of Francistown Centre for Illegal Immigrants as a prison

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the Minister of Labour and Home Affairs by section 3 of the Prisons Act, the following Order is hereby made —

1. This Order may be cited as the Prisons (Declaration of Prison) Order, 2002. Citation

2. The Francistown Centre for Illegal Immigrants, comprising the buildings and grounds within the fenced boundary covering 282.0805 (two eight two point zero eight zero five) hectares at Gerald Estate adjacent to the Gerald Estate cemetery lying west of the main road leading to Tati Village in Francistown, is hereby declared to be a prison known as “Francistown Centre for Illegal Immigrants”. — Declaration of
