ARRANGEMENT OF BYE-LAWS

BYE-LAW

1. Citation
2. Amendment of bye-law 9 of Cap. 40:01 (Sub. Leg.)
3. Insertion of new bye-law 10 to the Bye-laws

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 29 as read with section 30 of the Local Government (District Councils) Act, and with the approval of the Minister of Local Government, the South East District Council hereby makes the following Bye-laws —

1. These Bye-Laws may be cited as the South East District Council (Noise and Nuisance) (Amendment) Bye-laws, 2002. Citation

2. The South East District Council (Noise and Nuisance) Bye-laws (in these Bye-laws referred to as “the Bye-laws”), are amended by substituting bye-law 9 thereof with the following new bye-law— Amendment
of bye-law 9
of Cap. 40:01
(Sub. Leg)

“9. Any member of the Police Force or any person authorised by the Council may confiscate any instrument, bell, horn, record player, amplifier or similar device used for contravening the Bye-laws.

3. The Bye-laws are amended by inserting immediately after bye-law 9 thereof, the following new bye-law — Insertion
of bye-law
10 to the
Bye-laws

“10. Any person who fails to comply with these Bye-Laws shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding P100 or, in default thereof, to imprisonment for a term not exceeding 21 days and on a second or subsequent conviction to a fine not exceeding P200 or, in default thereof, to imprisonment for a term not exceeding four months.”
