ARRANGEMENT OF REGULATIONS

REGULATION

1. Citation
2. Amendment of regulation 5 of Cap. 01:02 (Sub. Leg.)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the Minister of Labour and Home Affairs by section 23 of the National Registration Act, the following Regulations are hereby made —

1. These Regulations may be cited as the National Registration (Amendment) Regulations, 2011. Citation

2. The National Registration Regulations are amended by substituting for regulation 5, the following new regulation —

"Fee to be
levied on
duplicate of
identity card

5. (1) Subject to subregulation (2), any person to whom a duplicate identity card is issued shall be required to pay a fee of P110 for such card.

(2) Where a person can sufficiently show that the loss, damage or destruction of the identity card was not a result of the person's negligence or carelessness, but was due to circumstances beyond his control, such person shall be required to pay a fee of P5 for the duplicate card to be provided.

(3) Any person who falsely declares in an affidavit that he has lost his identity card, shall be guilty of an offence and shall, on conviction, be liable to a fine not exceeding P2 000, or to imprisonment for a period not exceeding three years, or to both."
