AMENDMENT OF SCHEDULE (NO. 34) NOTICE, 1997
(Published on 24th December, 1997)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the Minister of Finance and Development Planning by section 52 and 53 of the Customs and Excise Duty Act, the Schedules to the Act are proposed to be amended to the extent set out in the Schedule below:

206.03/3004.10/04.06	capsules containing 500 mg amoxycillin trihydrate - 8,3% imported from Ranbaxy Laboratories Limited, India and originating in India.
