IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on him by section 175 of the Employment Act, the Minister of Labour and Home Affairs hereby makes the following Regulations —

Citation

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Employment (Declaration) of Government Industrial Class Workers as Employees) Regulations, 1997.
