ARRANGEMENT OF BYE-LAWS

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the Minister of Local Government, Lands and Housing by section 34 of the Local Government (District Councils) Act, the following Bye-Laws are hereby made —

Citation 1. These Bye-Laws may be cited as the Noise and Nuisance (Model) (Amendment) Bye-laws, 1997.

Amendment
of bye-law 3
of Cap. 40:01
(Sub. Leg) 2. Bye-law 3 of the Noise and Nuisance (Model) Bye-laws is amended by substituting paragraph (c) thereof for the following new paragraph —
“(c) continue to make any loud or unseemingly noise or disturbance either by shouting, screaming or yelling, or by blowing upon any horn or any instrument or by beating upon any drum or other instrument so as to annoy, disturb or interfere with the rest, peace or tranquility of the inhabitants of the neighbourhood, after having been requested to desist by any member of the Police Force, any person authorised by a District Council or any person so annoyed, disturbed or inconvenienced;”.

bye-law 4 of
Cap.40:01
(Sub. Leg) 3. The Noise and Nuisance (Model) Bye-laws are amended by substituting bye-law 4 thereof for the following new bye-law —
“4. Any person who fails to comply with these Bye-laws shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding P100 or, in default thereof, to imprisonment for a term not exceeding 14 days and on a second or subsequent conviction to a fine not exceeding P200 or, in default thereof, to imprisonment for a term not exceeding two months.”
