

PROCLAMATION.

BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE RIGHT HONOURABLE SIR HERCULES
GEORGE ROBERT ROBINSON, BARONET, &c., &c.

No. 1, 1896.—DATED 3rd FEBRUARY, 1896.

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient that the High Commissioner's Proclamation of the 18th day of October, 1895, should be repealed, and that the territories of the Chiefs Montsioa and Ikaneng should be withdrawn from the Administration of the British South Africa Company and replaced under the direct Administration, jurisdiction and control of Her Majesty's High Commissioner as portions of the Bechuanaland Protectorate:

Now, therefore, under and by virtue of the powers in me vested, I do hereby proclaim, declare, and make known as follows:—

Proc. No. 10, 1895, repealed.

1. The High Commissioner's Proclamation dated the 18th October, 1895, is hereby repealed.

Ikaneng and Montsioa's territories withdrawn from administration of B.S.A. Company.

2. From and after the date of this Proclamation the territories of the Chiefs Ikaneng and Montsioa as described in Schedule "A" and "B" of the aforesaid Proclamation of the 18th October, 1895, shall be withdrawn from the administration of the British South Africa Company, and shall be replaced under the direct administration of the Her Majesty's High Commissioner as portions of the Bechuanaland Protectorate, and shall be and remain subject to all the laws now or hereafter in force in the said Protectorate.

SCHEDULE A.

BOUNDARIES OF THE BAMALITI TERRITORY.

Bounded on the East by the South African Republic, on the North by the territory of the Chief Sebele of the Bakwena, on the South and West by the territory of the Chief Batween of the Bangwaketsie.

SCHEDULE B.

**BOUNDARIES OF THE TERRITORY OF MONTSIOA, CHIEF OF THE
BORA TSILE BAROLONG.**

Bounded on the East by the South African Republic to a place called Maiphetlane, thence on the North of Mahura's Pan, thence to the top of the hill Ngwabati, otherwise known as Korwe, thence to a point about a mile North-west of the Mogwalala Pans, and from thence on the West by a line direct to the junction of the Paring Spruit and the Molopo River. On the South by the Molopo River and the Ramathlabana Spruit.
