

PROCLAMATION.

BY

HIS EXCELLENCY SIR ALFRED MILNER, &c., &c.

No. 12, 1898.—DATED 30th JUNE, 1898.

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient to correct certain verbal errors, and to make certain amendments in certain laws now in force within the Bechuanaland Protectorate, including the Tati District:

Now, therefore, under and by virtue of the powers in me vested, I do hereby proclaim, declare and make known as follows:—

Laws amended.

1. The Laws enumerated in the first column of the Schedule hereto shall be and the same are hereby amended to the extent set forth opposite each such law in the second column of the said Schedule.

Commencement of Proclamation.

2. This Proclamation shall take effect from the date of its publication in the *Gazette*.

SCHEDULE OF LAWS AMENDED.

Laws.	Amendment.
Proclamation of June 10th, 1891 ...	Omit the words "by consent" in section 9; for the words "first regulation" in section 30 substitute the words "twenty-third section."
Proclamation of April 4th, 1892 ...	In the twenty-sixth section, for the words "in the Bechuanaland Border Police Force," substitute the words "any Police Force lawfully established in the Bechuanaland Protectorate."
Proclamation of December 2nd, 1892...	In the second paragraph of the preamble, for the word "aforesaid," substitute the words "of the Colonial Secretary of British Bechuanaland."
Proclamation of December 12th, 1892	In the second section, for the words "commanding the Bechuanaland Border Police," substitute the words "in command of the Police," and omit all the words after the word "Gaberones."
Proclamation of June 10th, 1893 ...	The first section is repealed.
Proclamation of July 15th, 1893 ...	Wherever the words "the Bechuanaland Border Police" occur, substitute the words "any Police Force lawfully established in the Bechuanaland Protectorate."

Proclamation of September 19th, 1893	In the ninth and eleventh sections, for the words "the Bechuanaland Border Police," substitute the words "any Police Force lawfully established in the Bechuanaland Protectorate"; and in section 15 (a) omit the words "British Bechuanaland or."
Proclamation of October 5th, 1893 ...	Repealed.
Proclamation of March 26th, 1896 ...	In the second section, for the words "Proclamation No. 6 of 1896," substitute the words "Proclamation No. 5 of 1896."
Proclamation of May 7th, 1896 ...	In the first section, between the words "and" and "wherever," insert the words "except in the third section."
Proclamation of June 22nd, 1896 ...	In the second section, for the words "Proclamation No. 6 of 1896," substitute the words "Proclamation No. 5 of 1896."
Proclamation of September 13th, 1897	In the first section, after the words "the High Commissioner's Proclamation of June 10th, 1891," insert the words "save in so far as any of the said provisions have been amended or repealed with regard to the Bechuanaland Protectorate."
