

PROCLAMATION.

HIS EXCELLENCY SIR ALFRED MILNER, &c., &c.

No. 13, 1899.—DATED 17th AUGUST, 1899.

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the provisions of the High Commissioner's Proclamation No. 17 of 1897, dated December 9th, 1897:

Now, therefore, under and by virtue of the powers in me vested, I do hereby proclaim, declare and make known as follows:—

Amending Section 2 of Proclamation No. 17 of 1897.

1. The second section of the said Proclamation shall be read and construed as though the following words were inserted therein after the word "Forces" in the ninth line thereof, to wit, "and any forces raised for temporary service being under the jurisdiction, authority and control of the High Commissioner."

Commencement of Proclamation.

2. This Proclamation shall take effect from the date of its publication in the *Gazette*.
