

PROCLAMATION.

BY

HIS EXCELLENCY THE HIGH COMMISSIONER.

No. 3, 1905.—DATED 20th JANUARY, 1905.

Preamble.

WHEREAS by an Order of His Majesty the King in Council dated the 24th day of October, 1904 hereto annexed entitled the British Protectorates Neutrality Order in Council 1904, provision is made for the regulation of the conduct of the inhabitants of British Protectorates and other persons residing therein during the existence of hostilities between foreign States with which His Majesty is at peace;

And whereas the said Order in Council as amended by an Order of His Majesty in Council dated the 14th day of November, 1904, also annexed hereto extends (amongst other British Protectorates) to the Bechuanaland Protectorate;

And whereas it is provided by section *three* of the firts-named Order in Council that it shall come into operation in any British Protectorate to which it extends on the day on which it shall be proclaimed by the Governor thereof;

Putting into operation the British Protectorates Neutrality Order in Council, 1904.

Now therefore I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known that the British Protectorates Neutrality Order in Council, 1904, as amended by the British Protectorates Neutrality (Amendment) Order in Council, 1904, shall come into operation on this date in the Bechuanaland Protectorate.
