

PROCLAMATION.

BY

HIS EXCELLENCY THE HIGH COMMISSIONER.

No. 55, 1908.—DATED 17th SEPTEMBER, 1908.

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient to alter the boundary dividing the Bakwena Native Reserve and the Bangwaketsi Native Reserve in the Bechuanaland Protectorate as defined by Proclamation No. 9 of 1899 dated the 29th day of March, 1899 (hereinafter referred to as the said Proclamation);

Now, therefore, under and by virtue of the powers in me vested, I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

Amending Section 4 of Proclamation No. 9 of 1899.

1. The description of the boundary of the Bakwena Native Reserve contained in section *four* of the said Proclamation shall be and is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the words “thence in a north-westerly direction to a point half-way between Luthlu and Sekgoma” and the substitution therefor of the words “thence to a spot in the centre of the Mafatels River immediately opposite to the said beacon; thence up the centre of the Mafatels River to its junction with the Kubung Spruit; thence up the centre of the Kubung Spruit to the spot where the said spruit is

intersected by a straight line drawn from the aforesaid beacon on the south side of the Mafatels River to a point half-way between Luthlu and Sekgoma; thence along such straight line until it reaches the said point half-way between Luthlu and Sekgoma."

2. This Proclamation shall be read as one with the said Proclamation and shall have force and take effect from the date of its publication in the *Gazette*.
