Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient to repeal certain laws in force within the Bechuanaland Protectorate relating to the disease known as Rinderpest on the ground of the same being no longer required:

Now, therefore, under and by virtue of the powers in me vested, I do hereby proclaim, declare and make known as follows:—

Repealing certain Proclamations and Notices.

1. The Proclamations and Notices of the High Commissioner contained in the Schedule hereto, to the extent set forth opposite each such Proclamation or Notice in the second column of the said Schedule, are hereby repealed, save as to any proceedings pending under any of the said laws or regulations, all of which shall be judged of and determined as though this Proclamation had not been published.

Commencement of Proclamation.

2. This Proclamation shall take effect from the date of its publication in the *Gazette*.
