

PROCLAMATION

BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE HIGH COMMISSIONER.

WHEREAS owing to hostile acts committed by Turkish forces under German officers a state of war has existed between His Majesty the King and the Sultan of Turkey as from the 5th day of November, 1914;

And whereas it is therefore expedient to prohibit persons resident carrying on business or being in the Bechuanaland Protectorate from trading or having commercial intercourse with persons residing or carrying on business in the Dominions of the Sultan of Turkey other than Egypt and any territory in the occupation of His Majesty or His Allies;

And whereas it is for that purpose necessary to extend the Bechuanaland Protectorate Trading with the Enemy Proclamation 1914 (No. 69 of 1914) herein after referred to as "the said Proclamation" so as to cover the state of war between His Majesty the King and the Sultan of Turkey;

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare proclaim and make known as follows:—

Proc. 1. The said Proclamation shall apply to the state of war
No. 88 between His Majesty the King and the Sultan of Turkey as
1914 from the 5th day of November 1914.

2. As from the said 5th day of November 1914, the expres-
sion "enemy country" in the said Proclamation shall be
deemed to include the Dominions of the Sultan of Turkey
other than Egypt and any territory in the occupation of His
Majesty the King or His Allies, and the expression "outbreak
of war" in the said Proclamation shall mean the said 5th day
of November 1914 in relation to the Dominions of the Sultan
of Turkey other than as aforesaid.

3. This Proclamation shall be read as one with the said
Proclamation and shall have effect as herein provided.
