

PROCLAMATION

BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE HIGH COMMISSIONER.

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No. 35 of 1915.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Bechuanaland Protectorate Trading with the Enemy Proclamation 1914 (herein after referred to as the said Proclamation) by prohibiting persons resident, carrying on business, or being in the Bechuanaland Protectorate from entering into transactions with persons of enemy nationality resident or carrying on business in China Siam Persia or Morocco;

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. Section *three* of the said Proclamation shall be and is hereby repealed and the following section shall be and is hereby substituted therefor:—

“The expression ‘enemy’ in this Proclamation means any person or body of persons of whatever nationality resident or carrying on business in the enemy country and any person or body of persons of enemy nationality resident or carrying on business in China Siam Persia or Morocco, but does not include persons of

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enemy nationality who are neither resident nor carrying on business either in the enemy country or in any of the countries above mentioned. In the case of incorporated bodies enemy character attaches only to those incorporated in an enemy country."

2. Where an enemy has a branch locally situated in China, Siam, Persia, or Morocco nothing in the proviso to section *five* of the said Proclamation shall be construed so as to prevent transactions by or with that branch being treated as transactions by or with an enemy.

3. This Proclamation shall be read as one with the said Proclamation and shall have force and take effect from the date of its publication in the *Gazette*.
