PROCLAMATION

BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE HIGH COMMISSIONER.

No. 44 of 1915.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend Proclamation No. 11 of 1911 (herein after referred to as "the said Proclamation") by adding to the powers of making regulations for the good government of Francistown thereby conferred;

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. Section *three* of the said Proclamation shall be and is hereby amended by the addition thereto of the following sub-

sections:—

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- (i) For regulating the slaughtering of animals and for prohibiting the slaughtering of animals in the said areas elsewhere than in a public abattoir appointed for the purpose or in such private abattoirs as may be approved by the Assistant Commissioner and for fixing the charges to be paid for use of a public abattoir.
- (j) For regulating butchers and the inspection, storage, and sale of butchers' meat.
2. This Proclamation shall be read as one with the said Proclamation and shall have force and take effect from the date of publication in the *Gazette*.
