PROCLAMATION

By HIS EXCELLENCY THE HIGH COMMISSIONER.

Entitled the Bechuanaland Protectorate Execution of Leases
Proclamation, 1919.

Whereas under the Bechuanaland Protectorate (Lands) Order-in-Council 1904 the High Commissioner is empowered to make grants or leases of Crown lands on such terms and conditions as he may think fit subject to any directions received from one of His Majesty's Principal Secretaries of State;

And whereas it is expedient to empower the Resident Commissioner to execute such documents as may be necessary to give effect to leases of Crown lands so made by the High Commissioner;

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. The Resident Commissioner shall be and is hereby empowered to sign and execute on behalf of the High Commissioner any lease or agreement of lease of Crown lands which may be authorized by the High Commissioner and any lease or agreement of lease so signed and executed shall be as valid and effectual for all purposes as if signed by the High Commissioner.

2. This Proclamation may be cited for all purposes as the Bechuanaland Protectorate Execution of Leases Proclamation, 1919, and shall have force and take effect from the date of publication in the *Gazette*.
