### **PROCLAMATION**

BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE HIGH COMMISSIONER

Amending Proclamation No. 26 of 1906 so as to make a further addition to the pensionable offices named in the Schedule thereto.

Whereas it is expedient further to amend the High Commissioner's Proclamation No. 26 of 1906 as amended from time to time by subsequent Proclamations (herein after referred to as "the said Proclamation") so as to make a further addition to the pensionable offices named in the schedule to the said Proclamation;

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. The schedule to the said Proclamation shall be and is hereby amended by the insertion therein immediately after the words "Resident Commissioner" of the words "Deputy-Resident Commissioner."

2. This Proclamation shall be read as one with the said Proclamation and the amendment hereby made shall be deemed to have been inserted in the schedule to the said Proclamation at the date of the taking effect thereof and to have had effect from such date.
