PROCLAMATION

BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE HIGH COMMISSIONER

Further amending the provisions of the Proclamation of the 12th of December, 1892, so as to increase the amount payable in respect of licences imposed on certain persons using or carrying guns in the Bechuanaland Protectorate.

Whereas it is expedient further to amend the provisions of the Proclamation of the 12th December 1892 as amended by Proclamation No. 23 of 1914 (herein after referred to as the "said Proclamation") so as to increase the amount payable in respect of licences imposed on certain persons using or carrying guns in the Bechuanaland Protectorate;

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. Section *two* of the said Proclamation shall be and is hereby amended by the substitution of the word "twenty" for the word "ten" before the word "shillings."
2. This Proclamation shall have force and take effect from the first day of January, 1920, and shall be read as one with the said Proclamation.
