PROCLAMATION

BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE HIGH COMMISSIONER

Further amending the Cattle Purchase for Export (Bechuanaland Protectorate) Proclamation, 1911 (No. 36 of 1911).

Whereas it is expedient further to amend the Cattle Purchase for Export (Bechuanaland Protectorate) Proclamation 1911 (No. 36 of 1911) as amended by Proclamation No. 48 of 1916, and herein after referred to as the said Proclamation;

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. Section *one* of the said Proclamation shall be and is hereby amended by the substitution of the word "fifty" in place of the word "ten" before the words "pounds sterling."
2. Section *six* of the said Proclamation shall be and is hereby repealed.
3. The words "or permit" shall be deleted wherever they occur in conjunction in the said Proclamation.
4. This Proclamation shall have force and take effect from the first day of January, 1920.
